1 Peter 1:17-21

Intro: (i) What motivates more? Fear? or Love?

1. Peter calls us to live in fear of the God of our salvation **1:17**

(i) You will be judged by a Father of infinite love (**1 Peter 1:17; 1 John 3:1; 2 Cor 5:10; Heb 12:28**)

2. Peter calls us to live in fear because of the high cost of our salvation **1:18-21**

(i) Because God has redeemed you from a futile way of life (**1 Peter 1:18; Matt 16:26**)

(ii) Because God has redeemed you by the precious blood of Christ (**1 Peter 1:19; Exodus 12:5**)

(iii) Because the foreknown came for the elect according to foreknowledge (**1 Peter 1:20; 1 Peter 1:2; Heb 1:2; John 17:5; Phil 2:5-8**)

(iv) Because your faith and hope are in the God of the impossible (life from death) (**1 Peter 1:21; Rom 6:4-5; Gen 1:27, 2:7; Ezek 37**)

Conclusion

Everyone will face judgment... but the child of God will be judged by a Father of infinite love.
